CONDOR DAY AT CCSC - FEBRUARY 8

We will have several Condor setups available if you don't have your own, but you are encouraged to bring your own Condor setup (PC or laptop, joystick and rudder pedals, etc). Pete and Frank will work with you to optimize your settings and get you going with XC flying in Condor.

The afternoon online session will utilize a local network provided by Frank, but you will need to have an internet-capable PC (wired or wireless doesn't matter) to join the afternoon race.

CURRENCY REQUIREMENT

The new currency requirement (UOP 4.2) that is now in effect requires each pilot to complete a field flight review with a CCSC instructor once each year in the highest performing aircraft in which he/she is qualified to fly. That checkout and logbook endorsement is a calendar year requirement. In other words, it needs to be the first flight that you make in a CCSC sailplane in 2014. So, plan now to take advantage of good weather during the winter to establish your currency and be ready for the first great soaring day of the spring.

To help you comply with the FAA Flight Review required by FAR 61.56 arrangements are being made for ground schools at which the required ground instruction can be completed. Take advantage of the ground school and avoid waiting for an instructor when the flying is good.

CAMPGROUND ELECTRICITY SHUTOFF

Attention trailer owners. It appears that electric power consumption through the campground meter is excessive. For the year the campground power bills total about \$4700, whereas the power consumed by all the rest of the gliderport comes to only about \$4900 per year. There is a possibility of an underground short that is draining power through that meter. To investigate that possibility all loads on the campground meter have been unplugged and will remain unplugged for one month. Meter readings during that time will help to determine whether power is being lost between the meter and your trailers. Contact Mike Hutchinson for further information.
