CONDOR DAY AT CCSC - FEBRUARY 8

You don't need any prior Condor experience or your own computer setup to participate, as we will be providing several 'loaners'. But we need to know how many will join in the Condor flying so we can prepare. Email paynterf@gmail.com and tell Frank whether or not you will bring your own setup (laptop or PC, joystick, Condor license, rudder pedals optional).

Frank Paynter and Pete Schradin will host a "Condor Day" at CCSC on Saturday February 8 (snow date February 15), from 10am to 6pm. The morning and early afternoon will be devoted to helping beginning Condor flyers with their Condor setups, and the afternoon will

feature a fun and easy 'online' multiplayer crosscountry race.

We will have several Condor setups available if you don't have your own, but you are encouraged to bring your own Condor setup (PC or laptop, joystick and rudder pedals, etc). Pete and Frank will work with you to optimize your settings and get you going with XC flying in Condor.

The afternoon session will utilize a local network provided by Frank, but you will need to have an internet-capable PC (wired or wireless doesn't matter) to join the afternoon race.

WINTER OPERATIONS

No decision has been made about off site operations while the CCSC field is too snow-covered or too wet for use. Crews should continue to report to CCSC on your assigned day as we continue annual inspection work on our fleet.

WILL THERE BE FLYING TODAY?

In response to a suggestion from a new member who lives a considerable distance from CCSC, cell phone numbers of crew chiefs have been added to the Frequent Flyer back page and also the Ground Crew page on the web site. The web cams provide visual evidence of activity, but a call to the crew chief may tell you whether a trip is worthwhile. This needs to work both ways, crew chiefs need your cell phone number so they can reach you. That information will be placed in the Membership Roster in the Members Only area of the web site. So, please provide your cell phone number to your crew chief.

ANNUAL INSPECTIONS OF AIRCRAFT

There will continue to be annual inspection work for each crew, so come prepared to help.

CURRENCY REQUIREMENT

The new currency requirement (UOP 4.2) that is now in effect requires each pilot to complete a field flight review with a CCSC instructor once each year in the highest performing aircraft in which he/she is qualified to fly. That checkout and logbook endorsement is a calendar year

requirement. In other words, it needs to be the first flight that you make in a CCSC sailplane in 2014. Crew chiefs will be provided with a listing of each member who has completed the field check and is eligible to fly CCSC aircraft. So, plan now to take advantage of good weather during the winter to establish your currency and be ready for the first great soaring day of the spring. This requirement does not apply to privately owned gliders.

PREPARE FOR FAA FLIGHT REVIEW

To help you comply with the FAA Flight Review required by FAR 61.56 arrangements are being made for ground schools at which the required ground instruction can be completed. Take advantage of the ground school and avoid waiting for an instructor when the flying is good.

CHAMPIONSHIP CONTESTS IN JUNE

CCSC will host the 126 Championships and also the Region 6 South Championships June 11 to June 22, 2014. Already 23 have signed up for the 126 contest and 5 for the Region 6 South. It is anticipated that a total of 50 gliders will compete, so special arrangements are being made to accommodate all the trailers and activity. For instance, the tow plane hangar will be used for all pilot meetings and meals because our clubhouse is not large enough.

Youthful legs and lungs are best suited for ground crew work, which includes assisting pilots in moving their gliders to the flight line, launching gliders in rapid succession, retrieving any gliders that need a re-launch, retrieving gliders at the end of the day when all return at about the same time, etc. If you are interested in helping or can recruit a teenager who will help, contact Todd Dockum: todd@thetechpark.com, 513-461-3535.
